## **Career Guidance – Civil Services**

V-ACT in association with Chanakya IAS Academy, Mangalore had organized a seminar on "Opportunities in the Civil Service sector" on the 26<sup>th</sup> of September, 2018 at 4.00PM in Bishop Aloysius Hall, St Joseph Engineering College, Mangalore.

The main speaker of the program was Mr Balakrishna Shetty – Former Ambassador of India to countries like Latvia, Bahrain, Republic of Senegal, Sweden and Mali. He was welcomed by the Training Officer & V-ACT coordinator Ms Flona Shawn Soans. Mr Shetty addressed the gathering and spoke of the various opportunities that the Civil Service provides to the young graduates. He also shared his success story of beating all the odds and clearing the examinations. According to Mr Shetty, the main reason why young graduates should opt for Civil Service is to get multitude of opportunities to help others. Clearing an IAS examination will enable you to work at a higher level where your sphere of influence is much higher than any other career opportunities. The Jurisdiction and the power that you get are great. He also mentioned that this career has provided him with a sense of satisfaction of doing something in return for the country.



He said that a bureaucratic post is not just a government job with the authority to wield significant administrative and diplomatic power, but a service that one performs by being part of the administrative process that forms the backbone of the country. A civil servant is a cogwheel

in the machinery that makes possible the day-to-day functioning of the government. Stepping into the role of a civil servant is about deploying a high level of IQ along with a very specific set of skills that one acquires as an aspirant and constantly hones for application in various domains of administration throughout one's career.

Developing this skill set is crucial to cracking the smartly crafted civil service examination that surpasses the traditional approaches of a job interview. It is therefore important to undergo a complex training program which focuses on test preparation. A successful UPSC candidate is expected to exhibit a sharp sense of judgement in complex situations, a certain level of emotional intelligence and a high level of righteousness. Preparing for UPSC is a journey that takes at least 2 years and brings out the best in an individual. He mentioned that the only formula for success here is hardwork as there are no shortcuts of any kind.

Mr Balakrishna Shetty concluded by saying that the Civil Service Examination Preparation needs an integrated approach of preparation for Prelims, Mains and Interview. Relevant studies with an approach of developing right attitude for problem solving, decision making and inculcating admistrative traits in personality are the basic requisites of the examination. Preparation under the right guidance makes the task simple and success oriented.

The career guidance session ended with a Q&A session and feedback. Mr Balakrishna Shetty was honoured with a memento by Collaborations Officer Ms Diana Monteiro. Vote of thanks was given by the Training Officer and V-ACT coordinator Ms Flona Shawn Soans. The event was compered by final year student Mr Jokshith D'Souza.

## **CLHRD**

## FEEL Communicative English

Batch One - 26 November through 01 December 2018 Batch Two - 03 through 08 December 2018

#### Introduction

St. Joseph Engineering College, Vamanjoor, Mangaluru organised 'FEEL Communicative English' learning and development intervention for the first year engineering students of the college in two batches, the first batch is from 26 November through 01 December 2018 and the second batch is from 03 through 08 December 2018. CLHRD, a unit of AIM INSIGHTS, the HRD Group. Kadri Road, Mangaluru was commissioned to conduct the six day human resource development intervention.

The Resource Team was led by the Director, CLHRD. He was assisted by four and five Master Facilitators of CLHRD in each balch respectively. The resource materials used were from the Intellectual Property Bank of CLHRD.

The themes that were presented during the course of the three days were Building Confidence, Developing Imagination and Intelligence, Influencing Through Communication, Personality, Freedom and Punishment, Values, Principles and Attrudes, Good Humans and Civilised Living, Vocabulary, Usage, Formation of Sentences, Grammatical Correctness, Use of Tenses, Interpersonal Communication, Mind Skills, Social Skills and Language Skills, Committee Speeches and Being Interviewed.

While 231 students registered in the first batch and 237 students registered in the second batch for the development intervention conducted, participation of the students were rated 'very satisfactory' by the Facilitators with the participants taking keen interest in learning the concepts presented. The sessions were from 09.00 a.m. to 05.00 p.m. on all the days of the development intervention with two breaks of 15 minutes duration each for refreshments, one in the morning and another in the afternoon, and a 45 minutes

break for lunch, everyday. Participants were divided into four and five batches respectively as per their batches of study with one Master Facilitator guides each batch. They were further divided into four and five mixed batches. Each mixed batch was also divided into different groups according to the type of activity conducted.

Daily evaluations on all six days and a course end evaluation on the final day of the development intervention were conducted Results of the compilation of the daily evaluations and the course-end evaluation are presented in this Project Completion Report (PCR).

Unlike 'FEEL Employable' or 'FEEL Leadership', 'FEEL Communicative English' learning and development intervention a conducted with the support of Peer Facilitators from among the participants. Towards this purpose, and also for deciding the current of the languages used by the participants, to design and customise the course, selected students numbering about 75 were trained to work as Peer Facilitators. A one day intervention was offered to these selected students to work as Peer Facilitators. They were also expected to continue the Communicative English practical work in groups of six after the 'FEEL Communicative English intervention was over. They were specially certified for the work of Peer Facilitators. The satisfaction rating of 80.8% (Bach One and 77.5% (Batch Two) was recorded by Peer Facilitators for their one day intervention. Peer Facilitators also underwent the FEE Communicative English' intervention like all other participants.

### The Research Results

Daily evaluations were conducted on all the six days of the programme on a rating scale of one to nine, with "1" being "Very Poor" and '9' being 'Excellent', to provide an opportunity for the participants to record their level of satisfaction.

The session concluded with a prayer.








# FDP 2016 Spoorthi Series: Yoga - Key to Better Health and New Life
