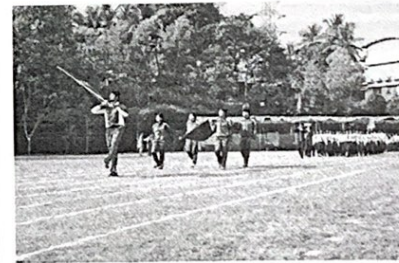
GO FOR GOLD - 2016


## Report on Alumni v/s Current Students Cricket Tournament

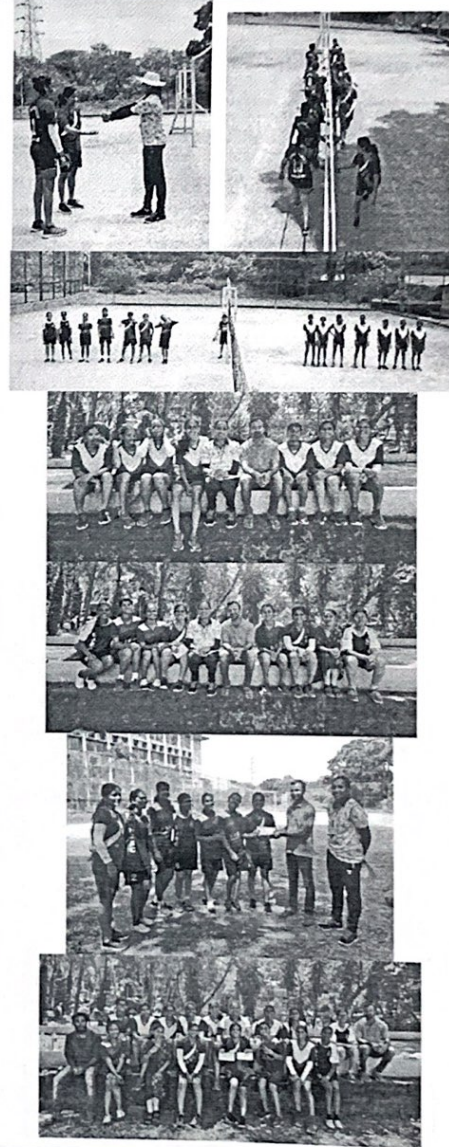
## Report on Alumni v/s Current Students Throwball Tournament


The Alumni v/s Current Students Throwball Tournament for men was held on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2019 at college Throwball Court.



## VTU Mangalore Zone Basketball Tournament - 2015

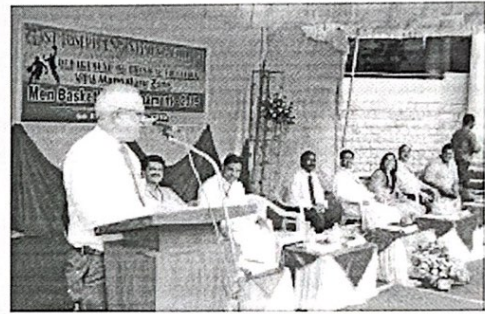
